## Annotation to discipline "Organization and planning of mining operations"

Total work content of discipline learning is 3 points of credit (108 hours).

**Purpose of discipline.** To shape students' knowledge about modern requirements for specialists in the field of transport of mining companies, mining operations, repair, and maintenance of mining, and prepare future professionals for the performance of official duties at work and to further explore the disciplines related to technology and organization of work in the development of mineral deposits. The implementation of this knowledge into practice will improve the level of organization of work of a mining and improve the basic technical and economic performance of his work.
